Eyes on Michigan: Election Officials, Election Protection Organizations to Host Press Call on Facts and Preparations for Election Day

MICHIGAN - Election protection and voting rights groups and advocates will be joined by Genesee County Clerk Domonique Clemons on Thursday, October 31, to discuss preparations and ongoing work to ensure every voter is able to cast their ballot and have it counted. Speakers will also discuss the non-partisan statewide election protection effort that is currently underway.

This virtual press call comes as voters across the state are utilizing the expansion of access to the ballot box that Michiganders voted to approve in 2018 and 2022, including early voting, no-reason absentee voting, and voter registration up to Election Day.
